HOW DOES THE RISK MANAGEMENT PROGRAM WORK?

The risk management insurance program now provides farmers with the tools they need to sustain their operations and provide safe, high quality, locally grown food to Ontario consumers.

Farmers pay insurance premiums representing 30% of the long-term cost of the insurance program with the federal and provincial governments contributing the remainder in accordance with the traditional 60/40 split.

The Risk Management Program helps Ontario farmers offset losses caused by low commodity prices.
